Page 2

This page will include the information up at the top and it will also include group pictures of both DTP classes and all of your names.

Ms. Johnson will scan the group pictures and give them to you on a disk. You will be responsible for placing the pictures on this page from the disk.

Pages 4 and 5

This is where you will place the text from the class letter you created with your peers. You can place a piece of clip art or an original piece of art on this page and have the text wrap around it if you want. See the example card for an idea of how to do this.

Page 3

On this page you should create a simple design with TEXT ONLY that says “Happy Holidays.”

Page 6

On this page you are to do nothing except record the information below in the same spot on your card. Of course you will want to change the name to YOUR name so you can have credit for your work.

The information at the bottom of this page is called the COLOPHON. A colophon is a notation at the end of a publication that gives the facts about the publication’s production.

Page 1

This is the first page of your card and the one you really want to be beautiful! This page should include only artwork - no words. For this page you should design your art in Illustrator, save it on your disk, and then place it into this PageMaker document.
